External Cladding Fire Safety

In a recent circular sent to all Owners and Residents on 17th July 2017, RHCFACT advised on behalf of the Executive Committee that we were checking that the exterior cladding of the building is not of the type involved in the recent fire in London known as “Alucobest”.

We are pleased to advise that safety compliant materials have been specified and used for the building construction. Cladding used above the ground floor is stainless steel. A physical inspection of the eastern ground floor cladding confirms that the product used is “Alucobond” that is a compliant cladding material as specified.
